Middle & High School Rules and Policies 2020-21



ELIGIBILITY:

The Youth Art Show is open to all full-time students in grades 6-12 in public or private schools in the Texas Panhandle. The student need not be enrolled in an art class to have his/her work considered for submission but must be supervised and sponsored by a school faculty member.

ENTRIES:

Any student who participates may enter only ONE work of art.

Artwork must be matted(in black or white) or mounted. Canvas paintings, textiles, and odd shaped paintings do not need mats/mounts.

Two-dimensional artwork cannot exceed 24"x36".

Three-dimensional artwork must be able to stand alone. Dimensions cannot exceed 24"x24"x36".

We are unable to accept any motion graphics and/or interactive media entries.

No entries will be accepted without the following attached to their artwork:

- A fully completed and signed permission slip with signatures of the artist and parent
- An Artwork Form with artist's first and last name, school, grade, and a title and description of the artwork which MUST be signed and dated by your supervising faculty member

CRITERIA:

Artwork evaluation will be based on the following:

- Execution and technique
- Aesthetics
- Personal expression
- Demonstrating an understanding of, and ability to apply the elements and principles of design in their own individual, creative style

AWARDS:

There will be two categories of judging: Middle School (grades 6-8) and High School (grades 9-12).

Awards will be presented to 10 winners in the Middle School Category and 10 winners in the High School Category. All winners will receive a cash prize and have their artwork displayed in the prestigious Globe-News Center for the Performing Arts in Amarillo, TX for a public viewing.
